The papers must be based on the original work of the authors and must not have been published elsewhere. Properly typed abstracts not exceeding 250 words (Times New Roman, font size- 12, single spaced in editable MS word format) should be uploaded on the conference website www.isvmconferences.com. The name of the presenting author must be underlined in the abstract. The last date for abstract submission is 31st December, 2015. The papers for presentation at the conference will be considered only if the presenting author registers himself/ herself for the conference on or before 31st December, 2015. Only quality papers will be accepted for presentation. The communication regarding the acceptance of the paper will be sent to the corresponding author by email only.

ACCOMMODATION

ABOUT LUDHIANA

Ludhiana city was founded in the year 1481, during the reign of Sikandar Lodhi. Situated on the banks of the Sutlej River, Ludhiana is referred as Manchester of India owing to its many small scale industries like hosiery and textiles, bicycles, auto spare parts etc. Ludhiana is a city of freedom fighters Sukhdev Thapar and Kartar Singh Sarabha, and renowned celebrities like Dharmendra, Sahir Ludhianvi and Juhi Chawla. Old Lodhi Fort in the heart of the city is still maintained and is hosting college of textile engineering. The nearby worth seeing places are Golden Temple, Jallianwala Bagh and Wagah Border in Amritsar, and Rock Garden, Pinjor Garden and Sukhna lake in Chandigarh. Besides, Vaishno Devi Temple, a famous Hindu pilgrimage is a six hour journey from Ludhiana. Usually, the weather in Ludhiana during February is very pleasant with comfortable days and cool nights. The city is very well connected by rail/ road to Delhi (320 km), Amritsar (136 km), Chandigarh (100 km) and Jammu (270 km). The nearest airport is Chandigarh (100 km). The university campus is approximately 5 km away from the Ludhiana Railway station and Bus stand.
