Subject: - Award of Dr. Balwant Singh Gold Medal for the year 2023-24 for B.V.Sc. & A.H. programme.

Dr. Balwant Singh Gold Medal is awarded at the University Convocation to one graduate adjudged as all round best on the basis of Academics, Sports, Theatre, Music & Dance, Debate, declamation, essay writing etc. and R & V NCC/NSS from amongst all the constituent and affiliated colleges of Guru Angad Dev Veterinary & Animal Sciences University, Ludhiana as per the following criteria:-

1. For the student to be considered for this Gold Medal, the minimum Overall Grade Point Average (OGPA) required is 7.00 out of 10.00 basis. The OGPA/Percentage of marks shall be considered upto three decimal points only.
2. The students must have graduated in not more than prescribed duration of his/her Bachelor's Degree Programme (Excluding extended B.V.Sc. & A.H. Internship period, if an intern is deputed by University for any activity or on medical grounds).
3. The candidates should not have appeared in any compartment/supplementary examination during his/her Bachelor's degree programme.
4. The candidate should not have obtained 'Fail' or 'Unsatisfactory' grade in any of the courses in his/her bachelor's degree programme.

(Cadets participating in these events in the individual capacity are not eligible for claiming any credit under this clause)

- (a) Gold (1.5 Points for 'C' and 1.4 Points for 'B' Certificate)
 - (b) Silver (1.25 Points for 'C' and 1.15 Points for 'B' Certificate)
 - (c) Bronze (1.0 Point for 'C' and 0.9 Points for 'B' Certificate)

- (i) For participation at the International Level competitions/events in Para Gliding/Mountaineering/Sailing/Parasailing/Rafting/Canoeing & Kayaking that are organized by respective International federation(s) of that particular sport and while representing India/NSS. (For holders of certificate 'C' - 4.5 points & for 'B' -4.4 points).

Grade 'B'

- (i) NSS volunteers for participating in Republic Day Parade at Rajpath, New Delhi.
(For holders of certificate 'C' - 3.5 points & for 'B' -3.4 points).

Grade 'C'

- (i) NSS Volunteers participating at the Republic Day Camp at New Delhi.
(For holders of certificate 'C' - 2.5 points & for 'B' -2.4 points).
- (ii) Medal Winners in All India Youth Parliament.
 - (a) Gold (2.25 Points for 'C' Certificate and 2.15 Points for 'B' Certificate)
 - (b) Silver (2.0 Points for 'C' Certificate and 1.9 Points for 'B' Certificate)
 - (c) Bronze (1.75 Points for 'C' Certificate and 1.65 Points for 'B' Certificate)
- (iii) Medal Winners in National Integration Camps/NSS Mega Camps/North East Youth Festival/National Youth Convention/Suvichar under National Youth Festival, Adventure Camps covering Para Jumping/Skydiving/ Mountaineering/ Sailing/Parasailing/Rafting/Canoeing & Kayaking Competitions at National Level by the respective Federation/Association/Regional Directorate, Youth Services fielding a team representing NSS as an Organization and whose NSS Volunteers have been selected after a due selection/Screening process. (NSS Volunteers participating in these events in the individual capacity are not eligible for claiming any credit under this clause).
 - (a) Gold (1.5 Points for 'C' Certificate and 1.4 Points for 'B' Certificate)
 - (b) Silver (1.25 Points for 'C' Certificate and 1.15 Points for 'B' Certificate)
 - (c) Bronze (1.0 Points for 'C' Certificate and 0.9 Points for 'B' Certificate)
- (iv) Participation in National Integration Camps/NSS Mega Camps/North East Youth Festival/National Youth Convention/Suvichar under National Youth Festival, Adventure Camps covering Parajumping/Skydiving/Mountaineering/ Sailing/Parasailing/Rafting/Canoeing & Kayaking Competitions at National Level by the respective Federation/Association/Regional Directorate, Youth Services fielding a team representing NSS as an Organization and whose NSS Volunteers have been selected after a due selection/Screening process. (NSS Volunteers participating in these events in the individual capacity are not claiming any credit under this clause). (For holders of certificate 'C' – 0.75 points & for 'B' -0.65 points).
- (v) Participation at the Pre – Republic Day Camp at the State level. (For holders of certificate 'C' – 0.5 points & for 'B' -0.4 points).

Note for NSS:

1. Only NSS Certificates issued by the NSS authorities/University shall be valid.
2. The above Scores shall be given if the candidates are represented through NSS Office only and the same has to be endorsed on the Certificate.

Eligibility for Different Categories of Certification for NSS candidates

'A' - Certificate:

The volunteer must have:

- Rendered 120 hours of service under NSS over a period of one year.
- Attended One NSS Special Camp of minimum of 7 days duration.
- Donated blood or coordinated/organized blood donation camp.
- Participated in social works like Plantation drives, Health campaigns, Awareness campaigns, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, Empowerment of Women, Social up-liftment of slums, Rescue & Relief during calamities, etc.

'B' - Certificate:

The volunteer must have:

- Rendered 240 hours of service under NSS over a period of two years.
- Attended Two NSS Special Camps, each of minimum of 7 days duration.
- Twice donated blood or coordinated/organized blood donation camps.
- Twice participated in social works like Plantation drives, Health campaigns, Awareness campaigns, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, Empowerment of Women, Social up-liftment of slums, Rescue & Relief during calamities, etc.

'C' - Certificate:

The volunteer must have:

- Rendered 360 hours of service under NSS over a period of three years.
- Attended Three NSS Special Camps, each of minimum of 7 days duration.
- Thrice donated blood or coordinated/organized blood donation camps.
- Thrice participated in social works like Plantation drives, Health campaigns, Awareness campaigns, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, Empowerment of Women, Social up-liftment of slums, Rescue & Relief during calamities, etc.
- In addition Participated in anyone of these activities like: Pre-Republic Day Camp, Adventure Camp, Mega Camp, National Integration Camp, National Youth Parliament, Youth Leadership Programme, NSS Republic Day Camp in New Delhi, International level Competition while representing India/NSS, International level Youth Exchange Programme/SAARC Countries Parliament or have been awarded Indira Gandhi National Youth Award.

Notes for all types of achievements for the Award of 'Dr. Balwant Singh Gold Medal':

1. Points shall be awarded only for the participation during Bachelor's degree programme as a bonafide student of the GADVASU at events organized by duly recognized organizations by Government/Statutory bodies for Sports, NCC, NSS and other co-curricular activities.

2. For the score card calculations, only the highest position/category rating points shall be considered on his/her being officially sponsored during the degree programme, for determining the merit for the award of the Gold Medal.
3. In case of individual sports discipline, position of the candidate in an individual event shall be considered and not the position of the team as a whole.
4. In case category of achievement and/or event of a student does not exactly match with the criteria given under different categories of achievements (Annexure –I, Sr. No. 2, 3, 4, 5 or 6), the score for the most closely matched achievement and/or event shall be awarded and for this the decision of the selection committee will be final.
