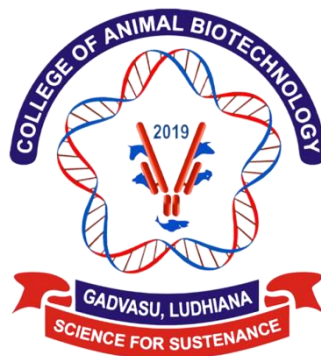

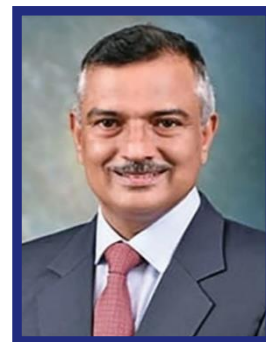

1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 The University

Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences University (GADVASU) was established on 9th August, 2005 at Ludhiana through Punjab Act no. 16 of 2005. Initially, the College of Veterinary Science (established in 1969), was shifted from Punjab Agricultural University to Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences University. The University has grown remarkably since its inception and is already amongst the top Veterinary and Agricultural Universities in the country. In order to produce highly efficient and skilled human resource for giving further boost to activities of livestock, dairy and fishery sectors in Punjab, the University has established College of Fisheries, College of Dairy Science and Technology and College of Animal Biotechnology for teaching, research and extension in the respective fields. The above four constituent colleges are at Ludhiana campus. Another constituent College of Veterinary Science was established at Rampura Phul, Bathinda.

The University has been accredited and recognized by the University Grants Commission (UGC) to receive central assistance under section 12(B) of UGC Act, 1956. The University got accreditation from UGC and ICAR and has been admitted as a regular member of the Association of Indian Agricultural Universities (AIAU) and Association of Indian Universities (AIU). Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) has accredited the University and its four constituent colleges viz. College of Veterinary Science, College of Fisheries, College of Dairy Science and Technology and College of Animal Biotechnology with grade 'A'.

The University has a Veterinary Polytechnic College at Kaljharani, Bathinda for the award of two years Diploma in Veterinary Science and Animal Health Technology. A private veterinary college, Khalsa College of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Amritsar and a private Polytechnic College, Baba Hira Das Ji College of Veterinary Pharmacy, Badal, Sri Muktsar Sahib are affiliated to the University.

1.2 College of Animal Biotechnology

During the last three decades, molecular biology and biotechnology have emerged with extensive applications in animal husbandry, medicine, industry, and environmental sciences. Recognizing the immense potential of biotechnology in animal sector, the Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences University established the Department of Animal Biotechnology in 2008. It was designated as School of Animal Biotechnology in 2010 and upgraded to College of Animal Biotechnology in 2019. The mandate of the college is to generate scientific expertise, human resource in various facets of animal biotechnology and to develop specialized facilities for research in cutting-edge fields of biotechnology. The college is also involved in basic and applied research spanning a wide-spectrum of areas like genomics, molecular diagnostics, vaccinology, stem cell biology, cancer biology, proteomics, and bioinformatics.



1.2.1 Academic Programmes

To cater the needs of undergraduate and postgraduate teaching and research, three departments viz., Animal Biotechnology, Microbial & Environmental Biotechnology and Bioinformatics have been created with excellent infrastructure and laboratory facilities. For the UG and PG teaching, the college is following the course curriculum as recommended by the ICAR. The college has been accredited by the ICAR with ‘A’ grade. 2.2 Admission for Post Graduate Diploma

1. For admission, candidates will be considered strictly on the basis of merit/marks of qualifying examination. In case two or more candidates are obtaining equal marks in the qualifying examination, the preference will be given to the candidate older in age.
2. The candidates, having higher degrees and in-service candidates deputed by the employer will be given preference in admission.
3. Change, if any, in application submission dates will be notified on the university website only. The aspirants are advised to visit the university website regularly for the updates.
4. The admission to Postgraduate Diploma is open to residents of all states and union territories of India, and to the NRI/OCI, wherever specified.
5. The admission form is available at the end of this prospectus. The candidates seeking admission have to fill the application form, and submit along with all required documents and proof of payment of application fee as scanned single pdf file attachment through email (at the address given in box) in order to reach the Office of Dean, College of Animal Biotechnology by e-mail to coabtadmissions@gmail.com on or before the last date fixed for receipt of the application form.
6. Only one application is to be submitted for consideration for admission to a particular course. If a candidate wishes to be considered for more than one course, he or she has to submit separate applications for each Postgraduate Diploma/Course and pay the application fee accordingly. It is to note that, at a time, the candidate will be admitted to one course only.

8. At the time of counselling, the candidate is required to present the hard copy of the submitted application form and the original certificates.

2.5 Mode of the Postgraduate Diploma Programme

- The Post-graduate Diploma in Molecular Biology and Genomics will consist of two Semesters of six months each and will be conducted in Hybrid Mode.
- One week of offline contact classes for each month of the Semester will be scheduled for practical.
- The Postgraduate Diploma in Molecular Biology and Genomics consists of total 28 credits in 10 courses divided in two Semesters.
- The candidates will be evaluated on the basis of End of Semester Examination and Research Projects/Surveys/Critical Appraisals.

3.5 Mode of the Short Course

- The Short Course on Bioinformatics will consist of two courses spanning over six weeks and will be conducted in Hybrid Mode.
- Last one week of compulsory offline contact classes will be required for practical and projects.
- The candidates will be evaluated on the basis of End of Course Examination and Projects/Assignments.
- The certificate will be provided to the candidates who successfully clear the course and exam/ project work.

4. REGULATIONS REGARDING RUSTICATION AND EXPULSION OF STUDENTS

1. The Dean of the college shall have the power to expel or rusticate a student for sufficient reasons, including acts of indiscipline and misconduct inside or outside the college.
2. Case(s) of rustication or expulsion of the student shall be immediately reported by the concerned Dean to the Registrar for registration and notification.
3. The Dean may revise his/her decision within 15 days of passing the order of rustication or expulsion. The revised decision composed with reasons shall be communicated to the Registrar for placing before the Academic Council.
4. It shall be obligatory for the college to re-admit a rusticated student if he/she wishes to re-join after the expiry of the rustication period.
5. The name of the rusticated student shall not be maintained on the rolls of the college and the student will not be charged any fee during the period of rustication.
6. A student expelled from the college shall not be allowed to seek fresh admission into the same or another college of the University without the sanction of the Academic Council. In no case, such a student shall be allowed to do so before the expiry of two academic years, excluding the academic year in which he/she was expelled.
7. Any fact that makes the Vice-Chancellor consider that the order passed by the Dean requires revision, the Vice-Chancellor may bring the case to the notice of the Academic Council, after consideration of the matter, the decision of the Academic Council shall be final.

8. Instructions/Regulations Regarding Anti-Ragging

“Ragging” is strictly prohibited in the colleges as well as in the hostels. Any student found indulging in the act of ragging will be strictly dealt with according to the directions given by the Hon’ble Supreme Court of India. According to Raghavan Committee observations, ragging has several aspects including psychological, social, political, economic, cultural and academic dimensions. The anti- ragging committees and squads have been constituted at the college level to keep a check on the incidents of ragging. If found guilty, it may invite punishment up to the expulsion of the guilty student from the institute or registration of F.I.R. under provisions of the Indian Penal Code. Every student and his/her parents/guardian are supposed to submit an affidavit that the student will desist from ragging in any form.

5. GENERAL INFORMATION

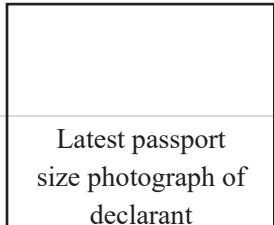
5.1 Application and Admission Process

- (i) Candidates may download the prospectus from the University website (www.gadvasu.in) and should carefully read the eligibility criteria, admission rules, etc. before applying for admission.
- (ii) The candidate appearing in the qualifying examination in the current year can also apply for admission.
- (iii) Candidates seeking admission to various Postgraduate diploma and short course programmes of the University must submit the duly filled-in application form with all required documents by the due date and time.
- (iv) Only one application is to be submitted for consideration of admission to a particular programme. Submitting more than one application for a particular programme is liable for rejection of candidature.
- (v) The applicants shall be granted admission on the basis of merit in descending rank, as decided by the selection committee. If a selected candidate, does not deposit the fees within stipulated time, the seat will be offered to the candidate, next in merit.
- (vi) Admissions to the courses will be as per dates and schedule mentioned in the prospectus and/or notified on the University website. The special counselling(s) and other update(s) if any, will be notified at the University website. The candidates are advised to visit the University website regularly.
- (vii) No separate intimation will be sent for counselling. For consideration of admission, the candidate must be physically present at counselling as per schedule. Absentees, for any reason whatsoever, will not be considered for admission.
- (viii) The candidates are required to produce original certificates and documents (as per check-list) to be verified by the Selection Committee, failing which his/her candidature will not be considered for admission.
- (ix) The prescribed dates will not usually be changed, even if dates are declared as holidays. However, if any change is mandated due to any exigency, it will be notified on the University website (www.gadvasu.in).
- (x) To avoid any kind of inconvenience or last-minute rush and/or any unforeseen difficulties, the candidates are advised to submit application forms without waiting for the last date.
- (xi) The students admitted to the various academic programmes in the University shall have to abide by all the rules and regulations (as applicable) of the Guru Angad Dev Veterinary and Animal Sciences University, Ludhiana.
- (xii) The Registrar may, at his discretion, cancel the admission of a candidate if at any time, it is found that the candidate obtained admission by misrepresentation/concealment of facts or the admission was made due to error, oversight, etc.

- (xiii) The University will not pay any T.A./D.A./or any other expenses for appearing in the counselling/ interview.
- (xiv) For selection of the candidates, the Selection Committee shall also consider the past record of the candidate. If, it is known that the candidate has been involved in any act of indiscipline in the hostel/ college/school/institute or in organizing unlawful demonstrations, etc., the Selection Committee may refuse admission to such candidates.
- (xv) Hiding of facts whatsoever may attract disqualification of a candidate, if it so warrants, as and when such facts come to notice of the University.
- (xvi) The selected candidates shall have to deposit the fee immediately agreeing to the terms and conditions. The selection notice will be issued only after the deposit of full fee by the candidate as per prescribed procedure.
- (xvii) No admission in short course and postgraduate diploma programmes shall be made after the last date of admission, unless date(s) for special counselling(s) is/are notified by the University on the website.
- (xviii) The Academic Council of the University is the supreme authority to frame rules and regulations, and to decide all other matters relating to admissions and academic affairs. The Academic Council also has the right to promote or discontinue any programme and also to increase or decrease seats in any programme, whatsoever.

5.2 Check- list of the documents to be submitted at the time of admission

- (i) Self-attested copies of educational qualification certificates and mark sheets from 10th class onwards issued by the Board/University, which qualifies candidate for the admission.
- (ii) Self-attested copies of Proof of Date of Birth and Character Certificate from college/university last attended.
- (iii) Self-declaration by the candidate (Annexure I)
- (iv) Self-declaration by the parent/guardian in the prescribed format (Annexure II).
- (v) Undertaking regarding Anti-Ragging by parent/ guardian (Annexure III).
- (vi) Certificate for in-service candidates (Annexure IV).
- (vii) Self-attested copy of Aadhaar/UID card
- (viii) Self-attested copy of Election Photo Identity Card (EPIC). The candidates who do not have an EPIC card must apply for the same at the website of Election Commission of India as per FORM-6 (Annexure V).

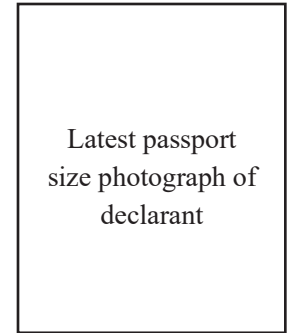
